The expenses are primarily for health benefits and payroll. She also informed the Commissioners that the 2013 budget is en route to the State Department of Community Affairs for approval. Due to Hurricane Sandy, no one has been available to accept the Proposed FYE 2013 Budget there since Friday, October 26. A Special Meeting will be required to adopt the budget. Executive Director Saundra Ross Johnson noted the year-end report doesn't include the City loan of \$250,000.

There is no evidence of CRA having sold the properties, however, the user built a structure on there (see handout). During an inventory inspection of properties, this structure was discovered. The sales price is based on the assessed land value. She is seeking to execute on the value of the land.  Commissioner Quinones asked: What is the area? Housing Director Olivette Simpson noted the properties are located on Broadway between Pine & Line Streets.  Commissioner Jose Vazquez clarified: Will we make money on land they improved?  Director Johnson confirmed and advised the Commissioners that she has been in discussions with the occupants; they are in agreement with the terms of sale. She also noted, through their consent, we are avoiding litigation that could eat profits.  There were no further comments or questions.  Ms. Simpson reminded the Board of its authorization of the development of a marketing campaign via 09-05-12C. Subsequently, in consultation w/NSP2 developers, it was decided that additional resources would be required in order to reach marketing goals. The expanded resources primarily include: a broader media plan, additional creative, and event planning in an amount not to exceed \$11,950.00.  Samples from the campaign were presented, reflecting the campaign theme: Work Here. Play Here. Live Here. The campaign timeline is October thru December 2012. It includes a 2-3 minute video.  Commissioner Vazquez noted that it may not be a bad idea to include information in the campaign regarding anticipated amenities (like the expansion of the Light Rail).  Director Johnson informed the Commissioners that CRA has a total of 55 units to sell by February 2013; 5 are sold and 15 are under contract.
